



10th annual All PSA Derby Rules 23-24 March 2019

- Read All Rules Carefully – Avoid Disqualification!!!

A non-mandatory participants meeting will be held on Friday, March 22nd at 6:00 p.m. at Village Pizza, 807 Commercial Ave, Anacortes (upstairs). All anglers will be responsible for information passed at this meeting. Saturday social will be held at Union Tavern at 6 p.m. Sunday awards will be held at Village Pizza at 1 p.m. No-host food and beverage each night. Monetary awards need not be present to win. Participants must be present for raffle prizes.

Moorage available for derby participant at Cap Sante Marina at these discounted rates:

- \$0.90 per foot/day
- 25% discount on launch rates
- Free trailer parking

All teams must check in with a derby official starting on Friday the 23rd and must be completed prior to fishing on Saturday. 1. The All PSA Salmon Derby will be held March 23-24, 2019 in Anacortes, WA. Fishing will begin at sunrise on Saturday and Sunday, but contestants may be underway before that time.
2. Weigh in times will be noon to 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, 10 a.m. to 12:30 on Sunday at Cap Sante Marina. You must be in line to weigh your fish by 4:30 p.m. on Saturday and 12:30 p.m. on Sunday and weigh your fish the same day they were caught. Fish shall be weighed whole and un-gutted and transported to the scales via boat or car. You may bleed your fish if you choose to. **Only 1 legal Chinook may be weighed each day per participant.**

3. Prizes shall be awarded as follows:
 - 1st Prize: 40% of ticket sales
 - 2nd Prize: 25% of ticket sales
 - 3rd Prize: 15% of ticket sales
 - 4th Prize: 10% of ticket sales
 - Secret Weight (>6 lbs): 10% of ticket sales
 - *Prize money calculated after \$5 pp allocated to Salmon for Soldiers!
4. Derby tickets shall cost \$40.00 per person. Derby participants must be paid PSA members (which includes family members). All personnel onboard fishing vessel must be entered to participate in the derby.
5. This is an all-weather Derby. Participants are expected to use reasonable judgment and common sense with respect to weather and/or sea conditions.
6. Each angler must have a valid WDFW license and catch record card. Each contestant must play and weigh-in his or her own fish (except where WDFW regulations allow for angler assistance).
7. Derby participants may fish only in Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Marine Area 6, 7, 8-1, 8-2 and 9. All fishing must be done in compliance with Washington fishing rules and regulations.
8. A participant placing in the top four will not be eligible for the secret weight prize. Prizes will be offered in descending order for heaviest salmon. In the event of identical official weights, the two tied weight-placing prizes will be added together, and the sum of monies will be split between the two tied participants.
9. The Derby judges shall consist of three persons. Any dispute concerning enforcement of the Derby rules or procedures shall be settled by majority vote of the judges. Judges are not eligible for prize money.
10. Derby officials may direct that a fish be gutted after weighing and/or that it be examined by a fishery biologist or other expert, at the judges' discretion.
11. Additional raffle prizes will be awarded by drawing. Each participant will be entered in the drawing for each fish weighed during the derby. **Only 1 fish may be weighed per participant/per day.** (daily limit in area 7 and 9 is 1, daily limit in area 6 and 8 is 2. Check regs for changes before fishing) Must be present to win raffle prizes.
12. Any changes to these rules, and any questions concerning these rules will be addressed at the participants meeting held Friday at 6:00 p.m. at Village Pizza, Anacortes. Any rule changes will be posted at that time. Derby participants agree to hold harmless the Fidalgo-San Juan Islands Chapter of the Puget Sound Anglers, derby officials, judges, sponsors, and/or their respective officers, agents, servants and employees from any demands, claims, and/or liabilities of any kind or nature from and for any injuries or damages of any kind that participants might sustain as a result of participation in the derby, including the awards ceremony. PLEASE DO NOT DRINK AND DRIVE. Derby officials would be happy to arrange for a cab at the contestant's expense upon request.
